University of Economics, Prague

The University of Economics, Prague (Vysoká škola ekonomická v Praze – the VŠE) is the leading university in the fields of management and economics in the Czech Republic, with more than 15 000 students and 600 professors. Study programmes at the university meet the standards and guidelines of the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). The VŠE offers a wide range of study fields in its Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral study programmes, both in Czech and in English. It has developed strong relations with partner universities and corporations from Europe, Asia and both North and South America. Within this framework, many courses are taught by visiting professors and corporate experts.

Economics of globalisation and european integration

This Master's Degree programme in economics is essentially geared towards students interested in careers in research, government and international organisations, as well as in research and strategy departments of large banks and industrial and commercial corporations. It is an English-language Joint European Studies Programme. The programme commenced operations in the academic year 1994/1995. The programme was selected by the European Commission as an Erasmus MUNDUS Master Course in September 2005 (for the academic years 2006/07–2009/10) and again in September 2012 (for the academic years 2013/14–2017/18). The programme is organized by a consortium of six partner universities, even though teaching itself takes place at only three of them each academic year. The selection of hosting universities is based on a rotation plan (details at egei.vse.cz).

Degree

The Master's Degree in Economics of Globalisation and European Integration is a joint degree of all six partner universities. Since the academic year 2007/08, the programme has been accredited by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic as a Master's programme of the Faculty of International Relations of the University of Economics, Prague (VŠE). The graduates are entitled to use both joint Master's Degree and title Ing. according to Czech legislation.

Programme description

- One-and-half-year full-time master's programme
- Taught in English
- Workload of 60 ECTS credits
- Programme divided into 3 trimesters, each taught at a different partner university, then students enrolled at VSE complete studies with one semester at VSE

Courses

- **Core courses (38 ECTS):** Advanced Microeconomics, Advanced Macroeconomics, Applied Econometrics, Economics of European Integration, Open Economy Macroeconomics, Economics of Globalisation, International Trade: Theory and Policy
- **Optional courses (7 ECTS):** Special Topics in International Finance, Special Topics in Applied Econometrics, Special Topics in International Trade, Economics of Regulation, Academic Writing, Mathematics for Economists, and the following languages: Chinese, Dutch, French, Italian, Spanish.
- **Dissertation (15 ECTS)**
